- ❖ Persons who may require photographs for passports / identification cards / visa and are unable to leave the institution due to their medical conditions e.g. babies and social cases.

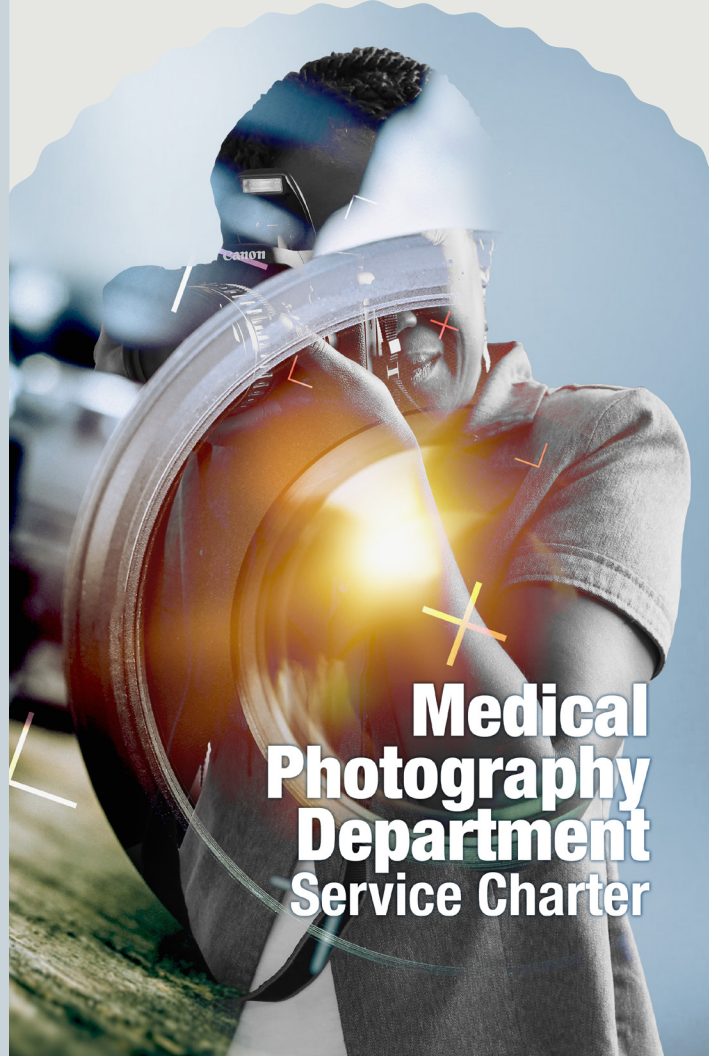

GUIDELINES TO BE FOLLOWED WHEN REQUESTING MEDICAL PHOTOGRAPHY OF A PATIENT

- ❖ Patients should be informed by their medical practitioners concerning the use of their photographs e.g. Medical Journals/Presentations etc.
- ❖ Patients written consent should be obtained in advance and in the case of children under the legal age (18) years consent of the parent/guardian is required
- ❖ Nursing staff should be informed concerning all request for medial photographs.
- ❖ As much as possible for photographs required during surgical procedures the patients consent should be obtained prior to them being anesthetized.
