## **HOW TO ACCESS SEWING ROOM SERVICES?**

### **Via Requisition Form**

- 1. Obtain Requisition Form from Stationery Stores
- 2. List all items required on Requisition Form
- Requisition form is then approved and signed by your Supervisor or Head of Department
- The forms are dropped off at the Sewing Room and recorded in the Request Book
- Request is then checked and put in order according to required date or availability of material
- When Linens are completed the department will be called or notified to collect their request

#### Via Email

- 1. Compose email listing required items
- Email sent by Supervisor or Head of Department to bballah-straker@swrha. co.tt
- Email is printed, stamped and recorded in the Request Book at the Sewing Room
- Request is then checked and put in order according to required date or availability of material
- When Linens are completed the department will be called or notified to collect their request
